Autism-Friendly Attractions

- **Walt Disney World:** Several quiet areas, and offers the disability access service at all four parks on Disney property.
- **Legoland Florida Resort and Peppa Pig Theme Park:** CAC certified, provide Sensory Guides throughout the park.
- **Aquatica:** CAC certified as well as **Discovery Cove**
- **Gatorland:** Outdoor attraction that has several quiet areas for guest relaxation. Home to the Gator Gauntlet, the only wheelchair accessible zipline in Central Florida.
- **Lake Eola Park, Harry P. Leu Gardens and Serenity Garden at Wekiwa Springs State Park**
- **Crayola Experience:** Offers Sensory Sundays including dimmed lights, music off and a quiet room. **See Ad on Page 25**
- **Kennedy Space Center:** Accommodations for people with mobility, cognitive, visual and auditory impairments.
- **SEA LIFE Orlando at ICON Park:** KultureCity Certified and equipped with sensory bags and signage.
- **SENSES Park:** An all-inclusive playground located in Osceola County that caters to children on the autism spectrum and is both certified as CAC and by KultureCity.
- **Central Florida Zoo & Botanical Gardens:** A KultureCity Certified outdoor attraction offering a single-morning quarterly Sensory Safari education program, designed for kids of varying abilities ages 5-12.
- **Kia Center:** The first NBA arena in Florida to be certified by KultureCity as Sensory Inclusive, meeting sensory processing needs for those families who want to attend an Orlan-

Members of the disability community can find joy though having fun while visiting many of Central Florida attractions, parks and amusements. Numerous attractions and venues offer accommodations to those with physical disabilities as well as those with cognitive disabilities. Attractions can qualify and earn certifications such as a Certified Autism Center (CAC) or Sensory Inclusive by KultureCity. Accreditation by the International Board of Credentialing and Continuing Education Standards (IBCCES) or KultureCity certifies that staff and team members have undergone comprehensive training and certification in sensory, environmental and emotional awareness. Many will provide sensory bags, noise-canceling headphones and fidget toys to enhance the experience for all.

 - **The Dr. Phillips Center for the Performing Arts:** CAC designation and offers sensory friendly shows, classes and camps.
 - **Urban Air Trampoline Park:** A sensory-friendly experience with refreshments, arts and crafts, displays, interactions and giveaways from local special needs-focused organizations.
 - **Orlando Museum of Art:** Creative Connections program on selected Sundays connects developmental and learning disabilities as well as autism spectrum visitors with art and the world around them.
 - **Universal Orlando Resort:** Detailed sensory guides are available for guests with cognitive disabilities.
 - **Orlando Family Stage (formerly Orlando Repertory Theatre):** Sensory-friendly performances each season accommodations include: lowered sounds and lights and quiet rooms.
 - **Brevard Zoo:** Sensory guides available for guests and various technologies available such as weighted laptop pads and noise-canceling headphones.
